Projects identified for this grant include energy conservation and sustainable measures, accessibility improvements, and structural and aesthetic enhancements. Proposed projects for consideration include:

- Replacing the original windows and doors on the north and west sides of the building with energy efficient windows and doors.
- Removing the iron post supports on the west exterior portico, which have become detached and replace with recommended pillars that improve the overall structural support.
- Repainting the east side of the building with appropriate historic colors.
- Supplying and installing James Hardie cement board siding on the north side of the building. The siding will be designed and painted by a local artist with an intentional themed mural showcasing the canal and the gateway into the downtown historic district.
- Upgrading the kitchen and bathroom that were originally installed in the 1950's. Finishes and fixture upgrades include cabinets, sink & faucets, soffit, counters, and flooring. The bathroom renovations include an accessible walk-in shower, vanity, toilet, and flooring.
